- 1.0 Few paras of BLW Tender Document pertaining to Local Content under Make in India Policy have been modified as detailed below:
 - a) para 1.15.3.3 is modified as under:
 In case of procurement for a value in excess of Rs. 10 Crore, the 'Class-I/Class-II local supplier' shall be required to provide a certificate from the statutory auditor or cost auditor of the company (in the case of companies) or from a practicing cost accountant or practicing chartered accountant (in respect of suppliers other than companies) giving the percentage of local content. No standard format for the CA certificate is given, however bidders must ensure that the CA certificate should contain at least "brief description of the item" and "percentage of local content". (Format given in Annexure 4.12 is for illustration purpose only.)

b) para 1.15.3.4 is modified at under
The certificates mentioned in para 1.15.3.2/1.15.3.3, as the case may be has to
be submitted along with the offer. Failure of submission of the certificates along
with the offer shall render the offer deprived of the benefits provided under this
order, viz. offer shall become ineligible for consideration in case of items
identified by Railways as to be procured from 'class-I local supplier' detailed in
para 1.15.3.7(i) below and for other items, it will be presumed that the tenderer
have no claim for Purchase Preference under "Make in India" Policy etc.

Note: This shall be applicable with effect from 01.12.2023.
